

PILOTS PLEASE READ

Welcome to Westbury White horse. Before flying please read and ensure you understand these instructions. Failure to do so could result in loss of the site.

There is an abundance of livestock in this area.

DO NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES LAND IN A FIELD WITH CATTLE OR HORSES IN IT.

The landing fields are marked with red borders on the map below. **NO SLOPE LANDINGS.** Good pilots can put down on the spur just past the nose of the horse.

This is a public place, do not obstruct the footpaths, leave room for the public to walk along the front of the hill and enjoy the views.

Be aware of the danger area downwind of the site, bordered in purple.

Do not fly low over the riding stables, marked with a blue border on the map. Minimum height 300' above take off.

Do not fly anywhere along the ridge where you are too low to reach the bottom landing field.
